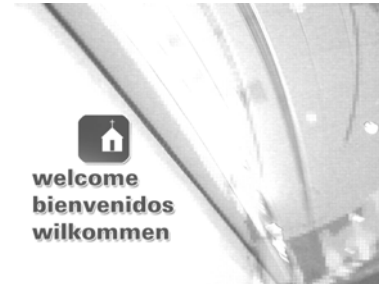
STRIVE - for high school students - meets Tuesdays from 7pm - 9pm

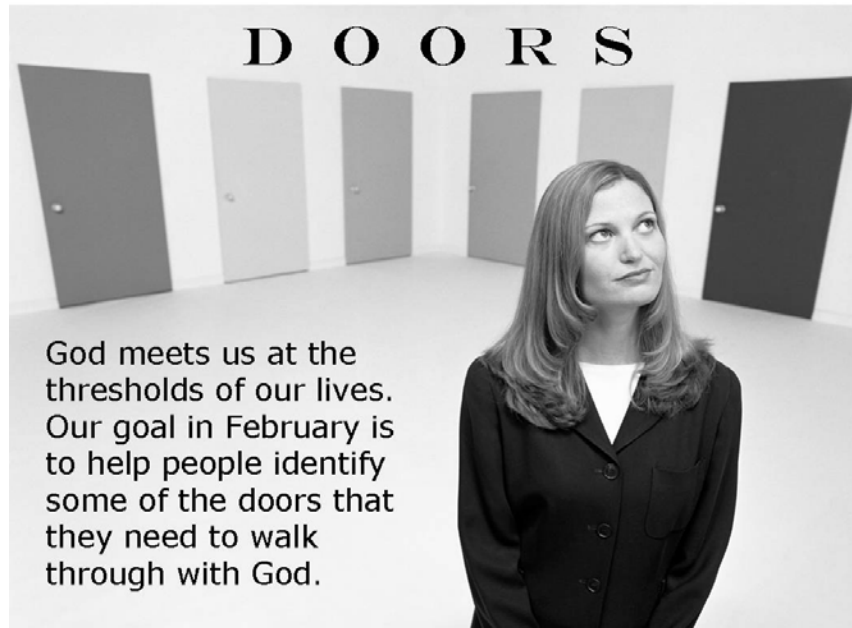
Our mission...
