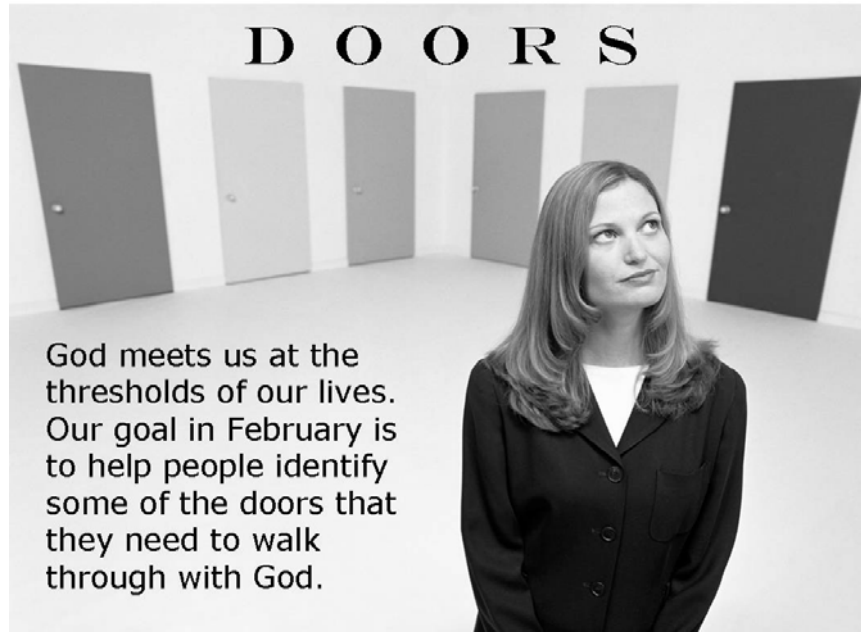
### Our mission...

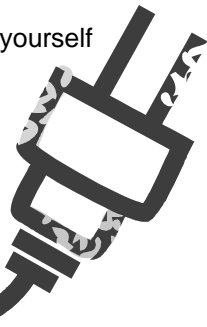
