## HOW TO GET THE MOST OUT OF 40 DAYS OF COMMUNITY

1. Look Back – Remember God's Faithfulness.

*They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.*

2. Look Ahead – Celebrate Your Future.

*But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.*  
1 Peter 2:9 (NIV)

3. Look Around – Commit with the Community.

*Then all the people answered together, 'We will do everything that the Lord has said,' and Moses reported this to the Lord.*  
Exodus 19:8 (TEV)

4. Look In – Prepare Yourself Spiritually.

Set aside time. Take inventory. Pray diligently.

*Create in me a pure heart, God, and make my spirit right again.*  
Psalm 51:10 (NCV)

5. Look Up – Get Ready for a God Encounter.

**Often, the most life-altering encounters with God require us to leave the routine, the comfortable, and the familiar.**
