We didn't want to address just her immediate needs (which happened to be a double stroller and infant boy clothing), we wanted to think BIG! Not only have we supplied those items we have also obtained a television, DVD player, gifts for each of her children and a gift certificate for mom to be pampered with a haircut and pedicure. The best part...we haven't touched our \$200.00 yet! Our goal is to make this family feel loved unconditionally, and without any judgment. We want her family to become a part of our family. We have discussed helping with grocery shopping, babysitting, birthday parties at our homes for the kids. We have some handy men in our group who can take care of home repairs, etc. She doesn't have a vehicle and everywhere she goes she has to take a bus with small children - that has to be a hardship. In the few weeks that we have been doing this community project I have learned so much from my group about love. I must be honest, my first reaction when I heard there were 3 children and a fourth on the way, it was a little difficult for me to empathize with her. After all she MUST know better. I know for certain God placed this project on my heart for a reason and every day I'm experiencing a little more of that reason. I have lived in my little sheltered world for so long I think God feels I'm ready to expand my horizons, and for that I am truly blessed!
