May 18th: There is a lady in our group that crosses the border frequently because her family is over there and she works there as well. She crosses 3x minimum per week. She has been taking the tunnel most every trip and she said that she's always known about this homeless man in a wheelchair who sits between the two lanes of traffic every single night on her way home from work but she's never really paid much attention to him. She's given him money in the past, but nothing more than change, because it's a big thing in the hospital she works at - they ask you NOT to give money because these people would be robbed and beaten up! So anyway, to tie in our 40 Days study to this...she was doing her daily readings and she came across the day that talked about sometimes showing love is simply offering a "cup of cold water" and an idea suddenly popped into her head. She went to the grocery store, purchased a case of bottled water and keeps it in the cooler in her van. And every time she goes through the tunnel she stops, gives this man a bottle of water and two dollars. She says, "This \$4 case of water is something that I can do to show him love for 24 days!" She really feels like she's now giving him something more than just pocket change. She described it like this, "Every time I give this man his bottle of water, I'm handing him a small bottle of LOVE!" Anyway, that's our story. It's not big and earth shattering, but how cool that a couple of times already members of our group have said, "You know, I noticed while I was reading, it said... And so I decided that I could do that too!" I like to see the teachings turn into real world stuff. Thanks for everyone's hard work organizing such a huge undertaking for our Church community!
