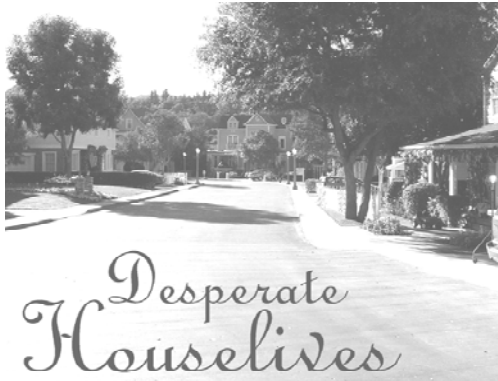
**WA** will not meet in September. The first meeting of the fall season will be held on Tuesday, October 7.

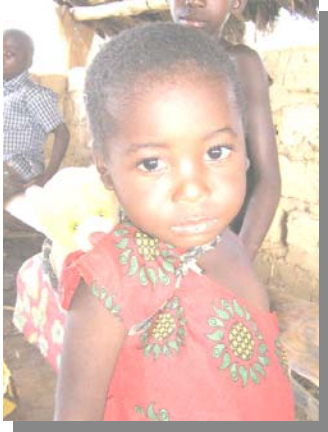
### Attention Parents of CHAOS and STRIVE (grade 6-12 youth)

# AIDS Orphans



In Sub-Sahara Africa

- 22.5 million people are HIV positive
- 2 million have died from AIDS
- 13 million orphans have been left behind

In one study they found that AIDS orphans are three times more likely to be hospitalized and seventeen times more likely to die prematurely.

Global Outreach, in cooperation with AIDS Orphans, is offering you an opportunity to respond to this crisis. In the foyer is a display, literature and a number of different opportunities to respond including:

*Purchasing a Zambian Orphans Choir CD - \$10 each*

*Sponsoring an Orphan - \$12 per month*

*Traveling to Africa with an Adult Work Team* doing construction, teaching, sewing, etc.
