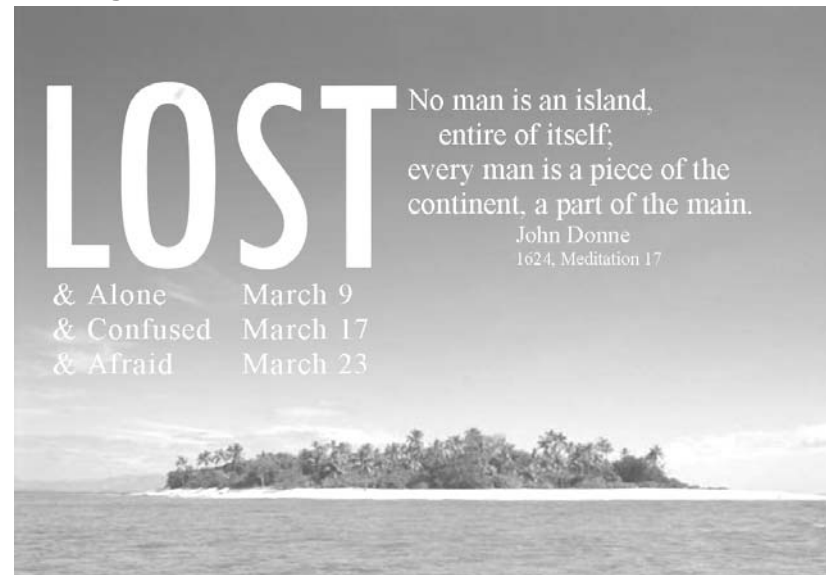
Our mission...
