STRIVE: for Gr.9-12 - Tuesdays from 7-9pm

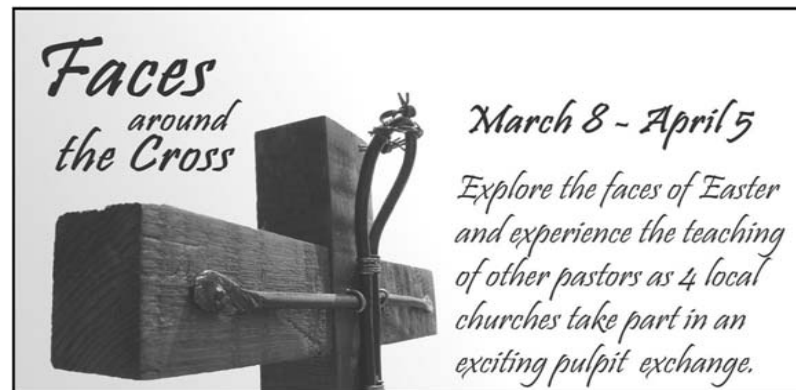
