Bob is a licensed minister, a member of the Ontario Association of Consultants, Counsellors, Pschyometrists and Psychotherapists, and has taught undergraduate counselling and theology courses at Master's College and Seminary. His degrees are in psychology, theology and pastoral counselling, with a special emphasis on the integration of faith and therapeutic interventions. He was privileged to complete his clinical training under Dr. Richard Dobbins, which included extensive crisis and trauma counselling at Detroit Medical Centre. Bob regularly speaks in the community and conducts enrichment workshops and seminars on a variety of topics. He has been featured on CKLW-AM800 and CBC Radio.
