“How come there are so many different churches?” Jeff asked.
“You mean denominations?” I clarified. “Yah, whatever you call
them. If Christians can’t get it right between themselves, how do
you know you’ve got it right?”

After thinking about his question, I had to admit to Jeff that some
churches get started because people aren’t perfect. Instead of
working through their differences and conflict in a healthy way
they just leave and move on to start another one. At other times
God uses different churches to reach different people. He loves
variety and this is reflected in the different kinds of churches.
Regardless of our many differences there is one thing that brings

And when we major on the Cross, rather than majoring on our
differences, we are an answer to prayer.
