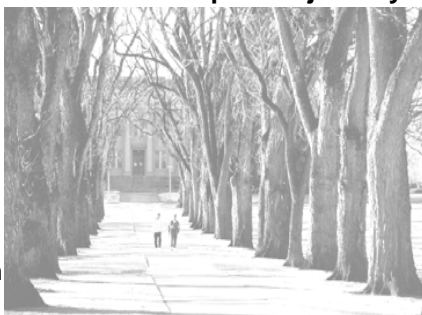

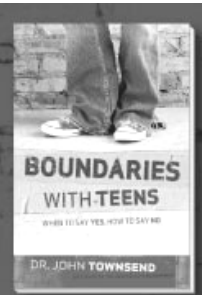

These days everybody is talking about getting rich or staying rich but nobody is talking about how to be rich.

The Bible states that God has already made you rich. He has given you everything you need in Christ Jesus.

What if we were to live like we were already rich? Wouldn't that be something?

God the Father has "blessed" us (v. 3-6)

...who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in Christ (v.3)

God the Son has "blessed" us (v.7-12)
